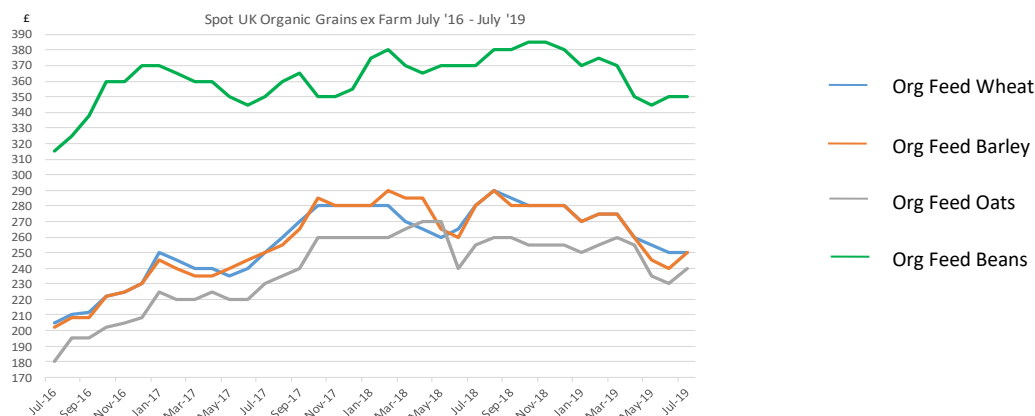


Saxon Organic Briefing – July 2019



Organic cereal market

UK organic growers that have harvested cereals report good yields, and now await their quality results from the Saxon lab. The broader European organic harvest continues without much disruption, with good wheat & barley yields reported across most growing regions. Due to anticipated good supply and current low feed demand, compounders are hesitant to commit. Organic feed wheat and barley are both trading at £250 ex farm (dependent on location), for September collection. For values further forward, please call us to discuss.

Organic premium cereals

Frequent spells of rainfall, coupled with warm & humid weather will negatively impact UK milling and malting quality. Dependent on quality, organic milling and malting varieties typically trade £30-£40 over feed. Organic milling oats are trading at £270-£275 ex farm, Sept/Oct collection. UK growers should have received our sample bags and freepost labels – please contact us if you have not. Once grain is conditioned, send your samples to us, so that we can provide your results alongside expert & accurate market advice.

Organic proteins

Compounders are showing limited interest in organic proteins, with feed demand still low due to good grass growth across the UK. Old crop supply still weighs on the market, and a weak GBP is deterring buyers. Meanwhile, organic new crop pulses are reportedly growing well.

New crop organic feed beans are indicated £350 ex farm for harvest collection. Contact us for more details.
